Making Appointments

Appointments can be made by phoning The Children's Doctor during operating hours or through our online booking service Ozdocsonline.com.au

If there are no vacancies with your usual GP, you will be provided with the option of seeing another doctor.

If all doctors are fully booked and you have an emergency, please advise reception so arrangements can be made to deal with the medical issue.

Urgent medical issues will be dealt with by the first available doctor.

If you or a family member requires an interpreter service, we can organise this for you. Please let us know when you make the appointment.

Types of Appointments

Standard - up to 20 minutes

Long - up to 40 minutes

Prolonged - 40 minutes and over

If you think you will need more than 15 minutes with the doctor or have multiple matters to discuss please make an appointment for a longer consultation.

Appointment Cancellations

Telephone Messages

Telephone messages will be returned when consulting time allows, if you require anything other than a very short discussion you should make an appointment. If the GP is with a patient, a message will be taken and the reception staff will advise you when it is likely that the GP will return your call.
